



For maximum design flexibility, the blades can also be installed from individual cable suspension or by direct attach method using Axiom® wall molding.

SoundScapes Shapes aesthetically define spaces with excellent sound absorption up to 1.15 NRC. Available in nine standard wood-look shapes—including triangles, trapezoids, and parallelograms—SoundScapes Shapes deliver strong acoustical performance in playful installations with angles, layers, shapes, sizes, and finishes on ceilings and walls. The shapes quickly install from the deck, drywall, suspension system, or on a wall in adjustable heights and angles. The panels can also be suspended as a group from the deck using a grouping frames kit to ensure alignment.

The online Armstrong Pattern Gallery features 20 different patterns complete with a bill of materials for installing these versatile ceiling and wall panels.
